Who is Eligible?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be 19 years of age and over
- reside in Ontario
- possess a valid Ontario Health Card
- have an ongoing physical limitation

Consult our Eligibility Criteria ([Word](#) | [PDF](#)) document for more information. Funding approval is based on the impact the device will have on the individual's personal mobility and independence, as well as on his/her financial needs.
